



Its an honor to launch Unchained Mothering within the WCCG



In Luxembourg women had to wait for 1974 to have full capacity if they were married, no wonders my 2 neighbors remained single and had a career.


CHILDREN?

WORK/ CAREER? CHILDREN





First you need Safety and Health, once this is guaranteed, you can start thinking.

Some can't afford staying at home with the kids,

some can't afford going to work

Some have the **privilege to chose** wether to **work or to stay** with the kids.

In 2022 33% women with kids under 6 years staying home versus 5 % of men.

Mothers of younger children remained less likely to participate in the labor force than mothers with older children. In 2022, 67.9 percent of mothers with children under age 6 participated in the labor force compared with 76.7 percent of mothers whose youngest child was age 6 to 17. By contrast, fathers with children under age 6 were more likely to participate in the labor force than those whose youngest child was age 6 to 17 (94.4 percent versus 91.8 percent). (See table 5.)

'Stay-at-home parent' will soon be an employment option on LinkedIn. It could help normalize caregiving.

'We shouldn't be ashamed of starting families or raising our kids,' one woman said

"All too often, people are penalized for taking time out of the workforce to care for their families. Employers are often hesitant to hire people who have gaps in their work history or will push them toward 'mother-friendly' jobs that are part-time and offer low pay," said sociologist Marianne Cooper, a senior research scholar at Stanford University's VMware Women's Leadership Innovation Lab.



Through art, women's stories, experiences, and emotions can be expressed, shared, and understood.




